LETTER

Erection of the New Parish of the Most Holy Redeemer

Since the spiritual needs of the people of the parishes of Santísima Trinidad and Sagrado Corazón de Jesús in Sta. Mesa, Manila cannot be properly attended to because of the small size of their parochial churches, because of the great number of their parishioners, and because of their large territory, with the consent of the Metropolitan Chapter of Canons, with the advice of the Vicar Foranes of the district, and opinion of the interested Pastors, We dismember by virtue of this Letter the territory of the said parishes of Santísima Trinidad and Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, and We erect the new parish of the [Most] Holy Redeemer with see in the Santol area, donated by the Gregorio Araneta, Inc. for the purpose.

At the same time, We establish the limits of the new Parish as follows:

IN THE NORTH: España Extension (from the Rotonda boundary of Quezon City—Manila to San Juan River);

IN THE WEST: Batanes Street (from the Rotonda boundary of Quezon City—Manila to Piña Avenue Extension);

IN THE SOUTH: Piña Ave. Extension, B. Tuazon, Santos, Vallejo, Brixton Hill, and Sta. Mesa Boulevard:

IN THE EAST: San Juan River (from Sta. Mesa Boulevard to España Extension).

All the inhabitants within those limits will constitute the members of the new Parish.

The endowment of the new Parish consists in the voluntary offering of the faithful, in the stole fees, to be paid according to our diocesan taxation and lawful custom, and in the property, which the new Parish may acquire in the future.

The new parish church has the privilege to keep habitually the Blessed Sacrament under the usual conditions, to possess a baptismal font, to administer all sacraments, and all other rights which belong to a parochial church according to the Code and the customs of Our Archdiocese.
